

## Creating a Works Cited Page

Use Easybib.com or Database Citation Function

### *What is a works cited page?*

The Works Cited page is located at the end of your paper and contains a list of resources that you used to complete the paper. All the works that you have cited in your paper need to be listed on the works cited page.

### *General guidelines to follow when completing a works cited page*

- The sources listed on your Works Cited page need to be listed alphabetically.
- Label the page Works Cited (do not italicize the words Works Cited or put them in quotation marks).
- Make sure to center the words Works Cited at the top of the page.
- Margins should be set to 1 inch on all sides of your paper
- The entire Works Cited page should be double-spaced. The second and subsequent lines of all entries for a citation should be indented using the tab key
