



Odyssey “Bring the Book” Team Presentations

To help us get a better grasp of the Odyssey books we’ve encountered, each student team will take responsibility for expertly presenting TWO (2) of the books from Parts 1 & 2.

Your team responsibilities include presenting the following:

- Brief Plot Summary: 3 major plot points (Beginning-Middle-End)
- Three (3) “Loud Lines” (powerful passages from the text) w/explanation
- One (1) character graph demonstrating the evolution of a main character over the course of the story (X-axis is TIME and Y-axis is a character trait of your choosing. For example, fear, guilt, power, empathy, ambition, pride, etc.)



- One (1) character metaphor depicting a significant character from your story. Provide pictures and explanation. (For example, if you were applying this to *To Kill a Mockingbird*, you might choose to represent Scout as a kiwi fruit because she seemed very coarse and rough around the edges on the exterior in terms of how she fought and prejudged others, but she became quite sweet by the end in demonstrating her affection and understanding of Boo Radley, saying “Hey, Boo.” and standing on his porch to see the world from his perspective.)
- Three (3) other literary elements (e.g. Epic characteristics, symbolism, figurative language/Homeric Simile, etc.) and an attempt to tie its contribution to theme.
- An interpretation (or speculation) of your book’s theme & justification for that interpretation
