| EVERYBODY | (EVERYBODY IS GOING to the dance) |
| NO ONE | (NO ONE IS GOING to the dance) |
| NOBODY | (NOBODY really CARES) |
| ANYONE | (ANYONE KNOWS the answer) |
| ANYBODY | (ANYBODY KNOWS the answer) |
