4. How many clocks are in your house?

Task: Visual Never Seen

5. Imagine your mom or your dad with a shaved head.
6. Have you ever been to Portugal? Imagine what the hillsides might look like.
7. Picture a dog whose hair has been dyed green.
8. Imagine a car taking off like a plane. What kind of car is it?

Task: Sound Recall

9. Which one of your friends has the deepest voice?
10. In your head, hum "Happy Birthday."
11. In your head, hum the alphabet and tell me what the 14th letter is.
12. Which clock in your house ticks the loudest?

Task: Simple Left-hemisphere Problem

13. What is $45 + 37$?
14. How many letter Es are there in the word *envelope*?
15. Make a sentence using the word *ocean*.
16. Recite the alphabet backwards.

Task: Simple Right-hemisphere Problem

17. What possible shape can you get if you combine two triangles?
18. Sing the do-re-mi scale.
19. Think about a facial gesture that an angry person would make.
20. Imagine you are about to catch a ball. Picture catching it.
